## Interruptions

- The average professional experiences one interruption roughly every 8 minutes, or 6 to 7 times per hour, totaling 50 to 60 interruptions per work day.
- Once interrupted, a worker won't immediately return to their task
  40% of the time.
- ► The estimated cost of interruptions to the American economy is \$650 billion per year.

- ► 50% of American employees say they work for only 15 minutes before becoming distracted.
- ► According to the NeuroLeadership Institute, people only truly focus six hours per week.
- ► In 2000, the average attention span was 12 seconds. In 2012, it was 8 seconds.

## **Impatience**

- Nearly 75% of professionals will tune out of a presentation after one minute if it doesn't have a clear point.
- ► More than **43% of professionals** abandon complicated or lengthy e-mails in the first **30 seconds**.
- Nearly a third of co-workers (32.2%) will tune each other out if they can't get to the point in 15 seconds or less.
